# Beacon Children's Hospital: Our Region's Only Children's Hospital

As our region's only comprehensive Children's hospital, we provide critical care for our patients close to their homes and families. More than 70% of our patients have public insurance, which does not cover many aspects of their care. Your support means we never have to turn a patient in our community away due to their family's financial circumstances.

Child Life and Creative Therapies When a child is sick, part of their childhood can slip away — at Beacon, we help Kids Be Kids by celebrating small milestones such as petting a dog, painting a picture, playing, or blowing out candles for their birthday. These are all services that insurance doesn't pay for and are provided at no charge to patients and families. Beacon depends on private gifts to support programs like pet therapy, art therapy, music therapy, and child life — all of which help engage children and reduce their anxiety. These positions are critical and funded almost entirely through philanthropy.

**Pediatric Cancer Services** Beacon Children's Hospital provides a full range of diagnostic and treatment services for children, from infants through adolescents, for virtually all childhood cancers. Gifts support a multidisciplinary approach that focuses on minimizing impact on daily life and provide a comfortable environment for patient care.

**NICU** Beacon Children's Level III certification provides the highest level of care available to fragile infants and their families throughout our region, ensuring excellent care and compassion support at an incredibly vulnerable time in their lives.

# **Nursing Education**

Nurses touch so many lives. They are a critical member of the care team and a lifeline for our patients and their families.
